## **INCOMPLETES**

An Incomplete grade may be assigned if you are progressing satisfactorily and, for valid reasons (emergencies such as serious illness or death of a family member), cannot complete the work of a course within the term. It is your responsibility to consult with your professor to determine if you qualify for the Incomplete grade.

If you are awarded an I (Incomplete) and you complete the required course work by the end of term for the following full term, the professor will change your grade from I to the appropriate grade (A - F). If you receive an I (Incomplete) and do not complete the required course work according to clear written criteria/schedule established by the professor in the following full term, your grade will be changed by your professor to replace the I (incomplete), your grade will be changed from an I to an F.

If you receive an Incomplete grade, do not register for the same course again until your course grade for the term you received the Incomplete for is finalized by your professor.
