IDH 2911. HONORS RESEARCH PROCESS.

HONORS RESEARCH PROCESS Prerequisite: Minimum grade of C in ENC 1101 or ENC 1101H or IDH 1110 and Honors Program permission. This honors course will introduce students to the process of research, tools, concepts, and resources necessary to search, evaluate, and use information in a variety of formats and subject disciplines. The focus will be to analyze and utilize information critically using a broad range of materials and interdisciplinary concepts needed for honors research and academic/professional success.

IDH 2912. HONORS PROJECT.

HONORS PROJECT Prerequisite: Honors Program permission and IDH 2911 This course provides the framework through which students in the Undergraduate Research Track of the Seneff Honors College, under the guidance of an Honors Research mentor, will produce and present a capstone research project.

Course content will vary each year, but will involve activities that satisfy at least one of the following program outcomes: 1) Recognize and weigh different perspectives in primary and secondary sources; 2) Produce original work and scholarly research; 3) Connect learning across academic disciplines.
