Spring 2020 Grade Options

Valencia College introduced new optional grades to limit COVID-19's disruption to academic plan.

Satisfactory/ Unsatisfactory- Does not affect GPA.

- Students opting in will receive one of the following grades:
Satisfactory + (S+), representing a grade of C or better
Satisfactory - (S-), representing a grade of D
Unsatisfactory (U), representing a grade of F

Retake- R20- Does not affect spring 2020 GPA and does not count as an attempt. No course credit awarded for spring 2020. Grade will affect academic honors.

- Student is unenrolled from a course and retakes it online in the summer 2020 term at no cost.
