MUC 2000C. COMPOSITION AND SONGWRITING I AND II. COMPOSITION AND SONGWRITING I AND II Prerequisite: Minimum grade of C in MUT 1011 or MUT 1111 A study of the basic elements of music composition through analysis, student projects, and listening assignments. Composition and Songwriting II is a continuation of the study of these elements. This course may be repeated for a maximum of 4 credit hours, but grade forgiveness cannot be applied.
