Admission Requirements

Students must meet the following criteria:

- Submit official transcripts from all prior colleges and universities with one denoting completion of a diploma from a nursing program or an Associate Degree in Nursing from a regionally or nationally accredited institution including course work with a minimum grade of C equivalent to: BSC 2093C ; BSC 2094C ; MCB 2010C MICROBIOLOGY; PSY 2012 GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY; DEP 2004 DEVELOPMENTAL PSYCHOLOGY; HUN 2202 ESSENTIALS OF NUTRITION WITH DIET THERAPY; NUR 1060C ; and 3 additional

credits in BSC or CHM or PHY. If not completed prior to admission, the courses must be completed prior to completing their second term in the program

- Have a minimum overall college GPA of 2.0
- Must have a clear/active, unrestricted, unencumbered RN License

Notes:

- Additional courses to complete the required 120 credit hours for graduation must apply to the degree and be approved by a student success coach.
- You must submit a copy of your clear/active, unrestricted, unencumbered Florida RN license prior to registering for NUR 3634
